KING AIR 200

The King Air is a ten passenger, all weather turboprop which flies at altitudes of 20,000 to 30,000 feet and at a speed of 300 MPH.

At a cost of \$720/hr., it is most economical when four or more passengers are scheduled to travel or airline service is not convenient. We operate the King Air with two highly experienced, well-trained pilots and match a level of safety equal to a U.S. major airline.



The King Air is supplied with coffee, bottled water, soft drinks and minimal snacks such as peanuts, granola bars and crackers. Our dispatch rate for the King Air is always nearly 100% as it can operate in nearly all types of weather.

Estimated travel times & cost:

When saving time and increasing productivity are important, the King Air will be fueled and ready, at anytime for your use. Although our first priority will be State emergency response, we rarely have had conflicts with other State transportation needs.

Cessna 206

The Cessna 206 is a single engine, five passenger airplane that is very well suited for flights in and out of shorter, unpaved runways.

It flies at speeds of 150mph and at altitudes up to 15,000 ft. Although quite a capable airplane, the 206 is restricted to flying in favorable weather.

Coffee, bottled water and minimal snacks are provided as well as intercom headsets for each passenger. Flights booked on the 206 must be flexible as decisions concerning acceptable flying weather will be made the day prior to the flight.



Although slower than the King Air, oftentimes the 206 can be an inexpensive substitute at \$238/hr. Estimated travel times & cost:

Cessna 182



The Cessna 182 is a single engine, three passenger airplane that is very capable for low level observation flights, wildlife surveys, airport inspections and cross country flights with fewer than four passengers.

Similar to the Cessna 206, the 182 flies at speeds of 150 mph and at altitudes up to 13,000 ft. It also requires favorable weather conditions.

The cost to charter the 182 is \$151/hr. Estimated travel times & cost:

Boise – Coeur d’ Alene	2 hour	\$736
Boise – Idaho Falls/Pocatello	1 hour 30 minutes	\$540
Boise – Salmon	1 hour 10 minutes	\$420
