



# Construction Update

November 5, 2009

Work continues in the following areas:



**1** Stage-one wall construction of the overpass access ramp is ongoing.\*

**North and southbound traffic on U.S. 95 has been shifted temporarily to the west through the work zone. Proceed with caution and obey flaggers at all times.**

**2** Stage-one wall construction of the southbound off-ramp is ongoing.\*

**3** Settlement of stage-three wall construction for the southbound off-ramp and common abutment is ongoing.

**4** Stage-four wall construction for the mainline roadway is ongoing.\* Settlement to follow.

**5** Brushing and grubbing is ongoing. Construction of pathway habitat enhancements are underway.\*

Construction of the bike/pedestrian path is scheduled to begin in one week.\*

**6** Sheet pile and H-pile driving is ongoing.\*

**7** Settlement of stage-one retaining wall construction for the mainline roadway is ongoing.

**8** Production pile driving for pier one (south side) of the S.H. 200 overpass is ongoing.\*

**Westbound traffic on S.H. 200 has been shifted temporarily to the center lane for 400' through the work zone. Proceed with caution and obey flaggers at all times.**

\* **Trucks will be entering and exiting from the various construction zones; flaggers will be utilized to facilitate the smooth flow of traffic.**

**Motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians should proceed with caution through the work zones and obey flaggers at all times.**

## ACCESS ISSUES:

*The bike/pedestrian path accessing the Long Bridge remains open during construction.*

*The pedestrian walkway at the eastern end of the Cedar Street Bridge is temporarily closed. There is no vehicular access to, or parking allowed at, the east end of the Cedar Street Bridge.*

*The road accessing the depot and the depot parking lot remain open during construction.*

**Construction work hours:** Monday through Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
