RE: Snake River Ave, Lewiston, Idaho – Hazmat Summary

Date: October 24, 2005

There are several EPA-regulated facilities within a half mile radius of the project area, however only one of these is of potential concern. This facility is ATK, previously called Ammunition Accessories Incorporated, CCI, and is located at 2299 Snake River Avenue and is listed as having a reported toxic release. The Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (IDEQ) Lewiston Regional office and the IDEQ State office in Boise were contacted regarding this site. The facility had a clean closure of corrective actions from solvent spills generated over many years. These cleanups were completed from 1992-1996, and semi-annual ground water monitoring is tracking the concentrations of the solvents, which are decreasing from natural attenuation. Based on this information, there is a very low potential that any hazardous materials will be encountered during roadwork, and a Preliminary Site Assessment (PSA) will not be required. This will be the conclusion included in the ITD-652 form, upon completion.

The Idaho DEQ has been contacted regarding the sites closest to the project. The site listed as LUST has the designation “cleanup complete”, therefore the probability of risk associated with construction in the area is low. ATK, previously known as Ammunitions Accessories Inc., CCI, Blount and Omark Industries, is a Large Quantity Generator and is in compliance with a RCRA Corrective Action.
