



Public Transportation Definition

- *Public Transportation* includes all multiple occupancy vehicle services designed to transport customers on local and regional routes. It is transportation by van, bus, or rail or other conveyance, either privately or publicly owned, providing to the public general or special service.
 - *Human Service Transportation* is arranged transportation for clients of a specific health and human services or education program where an agency pays for transportation services. Criteria, regulations and restrictions typically apply.
 - Coordination within each network, district and the state is imperative between these services in order to have an effective transportation system that connects all corners of Idaho.
