

Idaho Administrative Rules Governing Overlegal Permits

39.03.01 – Rules Governing Definitions Regarding Overlegal Permits

- This administrative rule contains definitions used in applying the remainder of the administrative rules pertaining to overlegal permitting.

39.03.04 – Rules Governing Movement of Disabled Vehicles

- This administrative rule contains requirements (class of vehicles, loaded weight, time of travel and hazardous travel conditions) for the movement of disabled vehicles.

39.03.05 – Rules Governing Variable Load Suspension (VLS) Axles

- This administrative rule contains definitions for fully raised and fully deployed VLS axles (sometimes called TAG axles) as well as providing three alternative methods for the sealing/locking of the pressure regulator valve which governs the weight applied on the VLS axles.

39.03.07 – Rules Governing Restricted Routes for Semitrailers

- This administrative rule provides the requirement that the Department creates a color coded map indicating certain routes upon which semitrailers, having a length of forty-eight (48) feet or less but exceeding an overall combination length of sixty-five (65) feet, can be operated on.

39.03.09 – Rules Governing Overlegal Permits - General Conditions and Requirements

- This administrative rule requires extra insurance or a bond from a shipper moving a load which is determined to be an “extraordinary hazard” upon the highways.

39.03.10 – Rules Governing When an Overlegal Permit is Required

- This administrative rule allows the Idaho Transportation Board to suspend/waive certain requirements for overlegal loads in the event of an emergency such as Military, Fire, Flood, Implements of Husbandry, Economic, etc.

39.03.11 – Rules Governing Overlegal Permittee Responsibility and Travel

- This administrative rule contains safety requirements pertaining to the movement of non-reducible loads as well as when a traffic control plan is required. Limits on time of travel restrictions, for overlegal loads, are also provided within this rule.

39.03.12 – Rules Governing Safety Requirements of Overlegal Permits

- This administrative rule contains additional safety requirements relating to special equipment (signs, flags, lights and 2-way communication) for overlegal vehicles and escorts.

39.03.13 – Rules Governing Overweight Permits

- This administrative rule contains requirements for annual permits for the movement of non-reducible overweight vehicles/loads. These requirements detail maximum weights allowed and sets forth bridge analysis criteria and time frames.

- This administrative rule contains general requirements and conditions for vehicles hauling reducible loads in excess of 80,000 pounds on certain classes of highways.

39.03.16 – Rules Governing Oversize Permits for Non-Reducible Vehicles and/or Loads

- This administrative rule contains general limitations for overlegal loads and allows for the permitting of multiple width or multiple height loads. This rule also contains information/requirements for the movement of overwidth vehicles and implements of husbandry.

39.03.17 – Rules Governing Permits for Manufactured Homes, Modular Buildings and Office Trailers

- This administrative rule provides all of the safety requirements (axles, brakes, lights, connection device, horsepower, etc.) for the towing or hauling of manufactured homes, modular buildings and office trailers.

- This administrative rule contains permit application requirements and vertical clearance requirements, as well as time of travel and insurance/bonding requirements, for the movement of buildings and houses.

- This administrative rule provides the color coded route designations and safety requirements for the movement of extra length vehicle combinations of reducible loads exceeding 80,000 pounds.
