Public meeting scheduled to discuss truck permitting draft rule changes

BOISE – A negotiated rule-making public meeting will be held on June 29 to discuss potential changes to Idaho administrative rules which govern the commercial vehicle permitting process.

The Idaho Transportation Board approved concepts for five potential rule changes at a meeting on June 8.

The meeting will be Wednesday, June 29, from 12:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. (MDT) at ITD's headquarters located at 3311 W. State Street in Boise. Verbal or written comments may also be provided at ITD's district offices in Coeur d'Alene, Lewiston, Shoshone, Pocatello and Rigby via video conference. Public input will be received until midnight on Friday, July 8.

The Idaho Transportation Department manages the process of granting permits for shipments that exceed a certain length, width, weight and height.

Administrative rules ensure a state agency's procedures are aligned with the requirements of policies and programs established by the Idaho Legislature, through Idaho code.
