
I-15 IDAHO FALLS BRIDGES PROJECT

MAY - AUGUST 2017





The Idaho Transportation
Department will do
preventative maintenance on
three bridges that cross I-15
north of Idaho Falls.

The work will include replacing guardrail, repairing concrete and resurfacing the bridge decks. The project will extend the life of the bridges for many years to come.

The bridges are located at:

- 81st North (Payne Road)
- 113th North (Shattock Butte Road)
- 200 North (McCarty Road)

Traffic impacts:

- I-15 will be reduced to one lane in each direction under the bridges during the day.
- The work will require closing the Payne Road, Shattock Butte Road and McCarty Road bridges for several weeks.
- The Shattock Butte Road and Payne Road bridges will not be closed at the same time.
- All lanes of I-15 will be open at night.
- Speed limits will be reduced.

The Idaho Transportation
Department will resurface
deteriorated pavement and
repair numerous bridges on
Interstate 15 in eastern Idaho
over the next several years.
The Idaho Falls Bridges
project is one of 10 projects
underway in 2017.

Overall traffic impacts will include:

- I-15 will be reduced to one lane in each direction in project areas.
- Interchange ramps and shoulders will be closed occasionally.
- Speed limits will be reduced.

To help you drive through construction, please:

- Plan extra time to travel through the construction zones.
- Pay attention to signage and changing traffic patterns.
- Slow down as speed limits will be reduced.
