UPDATE: Piccadilly Road remains closed until Thursday (Sept. 14)

The Idaho Transportation Department had to close Piccadilly Road at Idaho Highway 44 in order to replace an old irrigation pipe. ITD anticipates Piccadilly Road will be re-opened Thursday (Sept. 14), as one of the replacement parts was delayed in transit.

What to expect:

- Irrigation water will be turned off from 6 p.m. Wednesday (Sept. 13) until Thursday morning (Sept. 14) while crews replace the irrigation pipe.
- Piccadilly Road will remain closed until Thursday morning. Motorists and pedestrians should follow the signed detour routes.

Project schedule update:

- Tonight (Sept. 13) crews will continue to pave approaches between the cities of Star and Middleton.
- This week crews will pave ID-44 in the city of Middleton.
- This weekend, crews will pave approaches and pave the new turn lanes at Hartley and Middleton Road.

Dates may be adjusted as needed to keep the project moving forward.
