



CONSTRUCTION AHEAD – 2017

Construction begins Monday (July 31) on I-15 between Spencer and Montana State Line

Construction and lane restrictions will begin Monday (July 31) between Spencer, Idaho, and the Montana State Line.

ITD will resurface 15.3 miles of pavement and repave ramps and cross-streets at the Stoddard Creek and Humphry interchanges (exits 184 and 190).

What to expect during construction:

- Crews will work in four-mile sections, beginning in Spencer and working east.
- While each section is under construction, I-15 will be reduced to one lane in each direction and the speed limit will be reduced to 45 mph. The speed limit will be raised to 65 mph when crews are not working.
- Lane restrictions will remain in place overnight to protect motorists from areas with abrupt pavement edges.
- On- and off-ramps may be closed at night (10 p.m. to 6 a.m.) at exits 184 and 190. Only one ramp will be closed at any time.
