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## I-90, Northwest Blvd. to Sherman Avenue, Cd'A

Sept. 24, 2017 – Construction Update



Traffic remains on the eastbound side of Interstate 90, and is still reduced to one lane in each direction. Work zone crossovers are in effect for I-90 westbound, on- and off- ramps at 15<sup>th</sup> Street, and the Sherman Avenue on-ramp. Construction continues on the westbound lanes of I-90 between 9th Street and Sherman.

The work zone speed limit is **reduced to 45 mph through the city of Coeur d'Alene** and travel widths reduced to 11 feet with 15 feet of clearance.

A traffic switch will occur on Sunday, September 24 at 7 p.m. for I-90 traffic, between Sherman and 9<sup>th</sup>, putting them in the westbound and eastbound outside lanes. By September 30, all traffic will be in standard configuration.

**Motorists are required to yield to I-90 traffic when entering the freeway!**

This project will resurface I-90, increase height clearances between the travel way and numerous overpasses that exist throughout the corridor, and improve traveler safety with new guardrail, signs, and illumination.

Interstate Concrete & Asphalt, of Rathdrum, is performing this \$19.8 million Idaho Transportation Department project.
