

## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



### Broadway, Front and Myrtle construction update Sept. 13 -20

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) began to mill (remove the top layer of asphalt) on Broadway Avenue between University Drive and Rossi Street. Next week, crews will pave Broadway Avenue.

ITD has begun the work to rebuild pedestrian ramps along Myrtle Street. Unfortunately, the work to remove the existing pedestrian ramps is very noisy.

#### Broadway Avenue - what to expect:

- Broadway Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction between University Drive and Rossi Street from 8 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Motorists will drive on a temporarily rough surface.
- When necessary, flaggers will direct traffic at intersections.

*Construction will take approximately two weeks.*

#### Myrtle Street - what to expect:

- When a pedestrian ramp is under construction, a detour will be in place 24/7.
- Daytime restrictions may be necessary on roads that intersect Myrtle Street while pedestrian ramps are under construction.
- The work will be noisy.

*Construction to rebuild pedestrian ramps will take approximately one month. Once pedestrian ramps are complete, crews can begin work to repave the road.*

#### Front Street - what to expect:

- Pedestrians will be detoured on 10th and 12th streets while crews install the electrical conduit under Front Street.

*Construction will take approximately two weeks to install the electrical conduit.*
