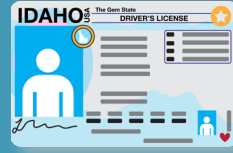




Should I travel with a Star Card–Idaho’s REAL ID or a U.S. Passport?

Beginning May 7, 2025, you will need a Star Card–Idaho’s REAL ID, U.S. Passport, military identification (ID), or some other form of federally-accepted ID to board a flight or access a federal building.

Side-by-Side Comparison

Legally Operate a Motor Vehicle



A driver's license is required to operate a motor vehicle

Board a Domestic Commercial Flight



Board an International Commercial Flight



Cost

Same cost as an ID card or driver's license (\$10 - \$55)

\$145 for new applications
\$110 for renewals

Turnaround Time

1-2 weeks from application
Cards can be renewed up to 25 months before card expiration date

4-6 weeks from application

At your local DMV office

New applicants need to apply in person, renewals can be submitted by mail

Physical Size

Wallet size

5 x 3.5" (when closed)

Social Security Number Needed?



Temporary foreign nationals not authorized for employment will have their USCIS number verified
