Purpose

This guidance includes: 1) helping to focus and prioritize programmatic activities so they are efficiently and effectively conducted on behalf of the state's bicycle-pedestrian interests, and 2) providing inputs for the creation and revisions of the Statewide Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan.
