If you are applying for an Idaho driver's license number or identification card number, Idaho Code Section 49-306(3)(a) requires you to provide your social security number (SSN) in order to be issued one of these credentials. If you do not have a SSN number, you shall complete and submit this section in lieu of providing a SSN and must also submit a birth certificate, passport or other documentation issued by an entity **other than** a state or the United States to show lawful status.
