

I-15 FORT HALL TO BURNS ROAD RESURFACING

MID-APRIL – FALL 2017



The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) will resurface approximately six miles of Interstate 15 from the Fort Hall Reservation boundary near Pocatello to Burns Road north of Fort Hall.

ITD will upgrade the guardrail along I-15 and improve the clearance below the structures at the Railroad Overpass, Fort Hall Interchange and Sheepskin Road. This fall, ITD will rehabilitate the Fort Hall Main Canal bridges once the canal is dry.

Traffic impacts:

- I-15 will be reduced to one lane in each direction in the project area.
- Both north- and southbound interstate traffic will travel on the same side of I-15.
- The Fort Hall Interchange will be open at all times.
- The speed limit will be reduced.
