

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) provides an exemption from the requirement to take a **skills test** with a CDL examiner for current or recently separated military personnel with certain verifiable experience operating heavy duty trucks while in military service.

Applying For A Military Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Skills Test Waiver

- Application must be made to ITD during active military service or within one year of separation from military service.
- This exemption is for the <u>Skills Test</u> portion of CDL licensure only; see ITD 3143 for combined knowledge and skills waiver or "Even Exchange."
- The military member must still take and pass written knowledge tests before the CDL will be issued.
- The applicant must possess a valid Idaho Driver's License at the time of application.
- Heavy vehicle driving experience must be current (within two years of date of application).

Required Documents To Submit To ITD

- 1. Completed ITD Form 3141, Application for Military CDL Skills Test Waiver, to upgrade to a CDL or upgrade your current CDL privilege. The *Commanding Officer's Certification of Commercial Driving Experience* (page 3) must be completed by your Provost Marshall, Company Commander, Department Head, or OIC.
- 2. Copy of DD-2 (Active Duty Military ID Card) or DD-214 (Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty).
- 3. Copy of Military Driver's License that clearly defines the types of vehicles you are/were authorized to drive.
- 4. If No Driver's License or Not Clearly Defined, additional documentation will be required, such as:
 - a) Verification of Military Experience and Training Document (VMET) that clearly defines the types of vehicles you are/ were authorized to drive, lists the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR), gross vehicle weight (GVW), and whether the vehicles are equipped with air brakes that you are/were licensed to operate in the military (this form can be obtained at DMDC.OSD.mil by military personnel only), or:
 - b) Documentation of the types of vehicles you operated or are/were licensed to operate in the military, that lists the gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR), gross vehicle weight (GVW), and whether the vehicles are equipped with air brakes that you are/were licensed to operate in the military. The explanations need to be on military letterhead, signed by your Provost Marshall, Company Commander, Department Head, or OIC.
- 5. This Instruction Page Fill out and return with your application and required documents. Include:

<u>Please allow 10 days after submission for your application to be reviewed</u>. You will be notified if your training is acceptable for an exemption from the CDL skills test requirement. After the exemption has been approved, the CDL knowledge tests must be taken at one of the county driver's license offices before the CDL can be issued.

The Commercial Driver License (CDL) skills test waiver form may be used by service members who are currently Idaho licensed and who are or were employed within the last one year in a military position requiring the operation of a military motor vehicle equivalent to a commercial motor vehicle (CMV). This waiver allows a qualified service member to apply for a CDL without skills testing. If you do not meet all of the requirements listed, you will be required to successfully pass the commercial driver license skills test. The transfer of School Bus(S) and/or Passenger (P) endorsements under this waiver program is prohibited.
