

Dealer Handbook: Dealer/Owner and Salesperson Application

Every dealer/owner and salesperson is required to be duly licensed for selling vehicles in the State of Idaho. An application (Form ITD 3171) must be completed for each person individually.

Every salesperson/owner/dealer must be able to produce his/her temporary or permanent salesperson license at all times while engaging in selling vehicles.

• Dealers, Owners, Officers:

All dealers, owners, partners, corporate officers, or directors must complete application form ITD 3171 to obtain a sales license.

• Inactive Owners:

Inactive owners/corporate officers must also submit application ITD 3171, but are not required to obtain identification cards (please see "Permanent Licenses" below).

• Salespersons:

All hired salespersons must be 18 years of age or older and must be employed by a licensed Idaho vehicle dealer to qualify for a salesperson license. They, too, must complete form ITD 3171. The sponsoring dealer must co-sign the application and, by doing so, certifies that s/he deems the applicant suitable for a salesperson position.

• Temporary Dealer/Owner/Salesperson Licenses:

The Department will process the application and send a temporary license to the sponsoring dealership. A temporary license is generally valid for 30 days, unless otherwise stated.

• Permanent Dealer/Owner/Salesperson Licenses:

The applicant has the obligation to obtain a permanent license (with ID picture taken) at their local DMV within the stated time period (generally 30 days).

Inactive owners are exempt from obtaining a permanent salesperson ID card.

• Validity:

All dealer/owner/salesperson licenses are valid for 3 years from the date on the application.

• Renewals:

All salesperson/owner/dealer/inactive owner licenses must be renewed at their expiration date or the holder will no longer be qualified to sell vehicles in the State of Idaho.

• Salesperson Changing Sponsoring Dealership:

If a salesperson changes sponsoring dealership, s/he must submit a new application and fee and will receive an update to his or her existing license.

• Temporary Off-Site Sales License:

If a dealer hires sales personnel for a specific, temporary, off-site sales event, the applicants must



submit form ITD3171, duly completed, as well as the required fee. A temporary off-site sales license will be valid for 30 days, no photo is required and no ID card will be provided.

• Cancellation:

If a salesperson leaves a dealership, the dealer should advise the Department so that the salesperson will not continue being associated with that dealership.
