

Drive Insured!

A law passed by the 2019 Idaho Legislature requires registered vehicle owners have insurance or DMV will suspend their registration.



Starting January 1, 2020,

the Idaho Transportation Department Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will use an online insurance verification system to ensure vehicle owners have insurance coverage. Vehicle owners without insurance will have their registration suspended.

Frequently Asked Questions

FAQs

1. Who is affected?

- a. *All owners of registered vehicles. Vehicle owners without coverage for two consecutive months will receive a warning and will be given 30 days to provide proof of insurance or obtain an exemption before registration is suspended.*

2. How will DMV verify my vehicle insurance?

- a. *The DMV receives data from licensed Idaho insurance companies identifying vehicles that have coverage.*

3. What if I'm insured by an out-of-state company?

- a. *If you have a policy from an out-of-state insurer that is not reported to the Idaho DMV, you will be classified as not having insurance until an alternative method of proof is provided.*

4. How can I reinstate my suspended registration?

- a. *You will have to provide proof of insurance and pay a reinstatement fee of \$75. Payment can be made by phone, mail, or email.*
