



## OVERLEGAL PERMIT OPERATIONS

### Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to implement Board policy 4072 on issuing overlegal permits.

### Legal Authority

- Idaho Code 40-310(10) - Restrict use of any state highway whenever a restriction is deemed necessary by the Board for the protection of the public or for the protection of the highway or any section from damage.
- Idaho Code 40-312(1) - Prescribe rules and regulations affecting state highways.
- Idaho Code 40-505 - The Director shall enforce all laws related to the Department and exercise all necessary powers.
- Idaho Code 49-1004 - Permits for overweight or oversize loads on state highways.
- Idaho Code 49-1010 - General rule of size of vehicles and loads allowed on state highways.
- Idaho Code 49-1011 - Specific exceptions regarding allowed size of vehicles and loads allowed on state highways.

The Division of Engineering Services Administrator or a delegate shall develop maps of the State Highway System establishing:

- Route capacity (weight, width, length, and height).
- Designated routes for extra-length vehicle combinations.
- Designated routes for up to 129,000 pound vehicle combinations.
- Vertical clearances.
- Pilot car and travel time requirements.
- 48 feet or less trailers exceeding 65 feet overall length.

Attendant regulations, requirements, and specifications shall be made part of the map which shall be distributed to applicants for Overlegal Permits or Certificates of Compliance.

The maps shall be updated as necessary to reflect any pertinent changes or as requested by the Idaho Transportation Board.

Overlegal Permit Operations shall be managed by the Motor Carrier Services Manager as part of the Division of Motor Vehicles.
