What is ADA Transition?

Americans with Disabilities Act Transition is the process of eliminating accessibility barriers to existing pedestrian infrastructure on the State Highway System



What is not included in ADA Transition?



Reconstructing accessible pedestrian routes



Constructing "missing" links or expanding pedestrian routes

Draft ADA Transition Plan identifies the programs that will fund improvements



Planned \$35 Million investment over 15 years



Coordination with local agencies with maintenance responsibilities
