

TOP 10 WINTER DRIVING TIPS

- Check the road conditions before traveling. Visit 511.idaho.gov or download the Idaho 511 app
- Be prepared. Keep a winter emergency kit in your car with food/water, etc.
- When roads are wet or icy, slow down and give yourself more stopping distance. Remember, bridges and overpasses are the first to freeze when temperatures drop
- Turn off cruise control if roads are slick
- If you do slide, stay calm, brake very gently, and turn your wheel in the direction of the skid. Try not to overcorrect

- Keep your windshield completely clear of snow and ice. Fill up on windshield washer fluid too
- Learn how to use tire chains and carry them with you
- Let someone know your travel plans, especially if you'll be driving through areas with no cell service
- Give our snowplow drivers room to work. Never pass a snowplow on the right! The safest place is behind the plow
- Buckle up, stay engaged behind the wheel, and drive for the conditions this winter
