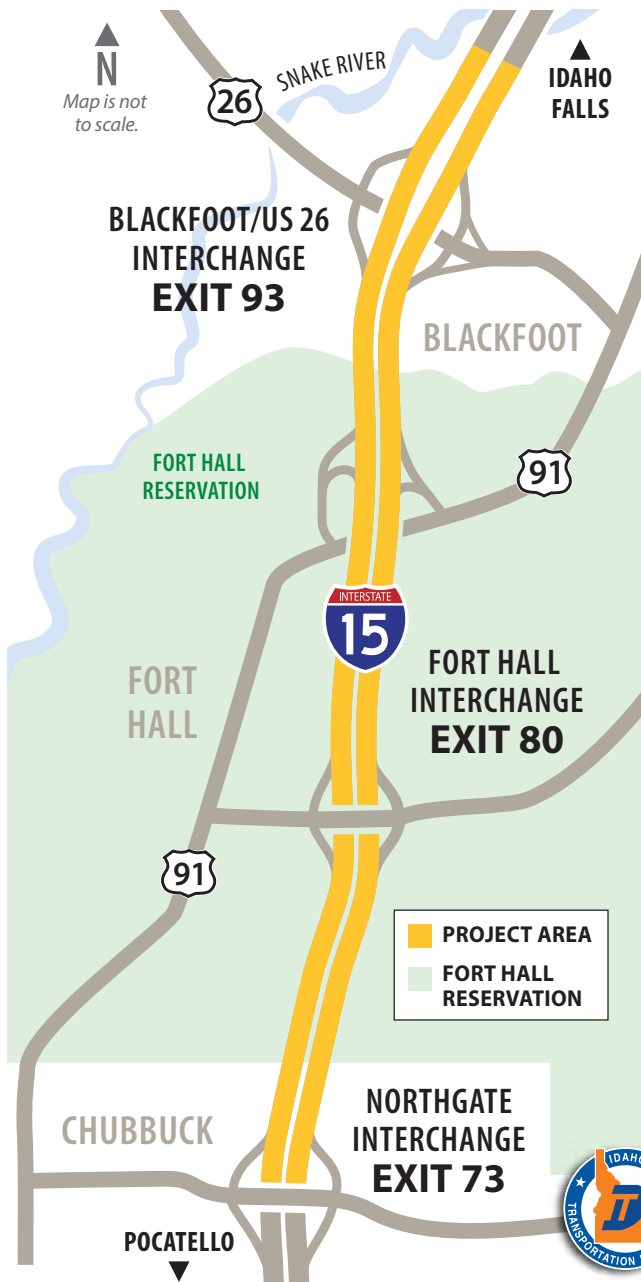


The Idaho Transportation Department is designing improvements to I-15 to modernize aging infrastructure, increase capacity, and improve safety on the interstate to meet increased population and travel demands across the region. The project begins at the Northgate Parkway Interchange (Exit 73) and ends

approximately 1 mile north of the Blackfoot/US 26 Interchange (Exit 93).

ANTICIPATED IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements will be designed using technical data, environmental studies and input from the public. Improvements to be considered include:

- Widening Interstate 15 and improving the driving surface
- Improving bridges, overpasses and interchange structures
- Increasing the vertical clearance on overhead structures

Begin environmental evaluation, gather traffic and geotechnical information, survey and develop improvement concepts	2022
Develop preliminary engineering designs and continue environmental evaluation	2022-2023
Complete environmental evaluation and final engineering design plans	2023-2024
Construct improvements	TBD
