

Full Fee Registration (Idaho and non-Idaho)

Full Fee is a type of motor carrier vehicle registration for which Idaho's "full" registration fees are charged in accordance with Section 49-434, Idaho Code.

Any commercial carrier may fully register (Full Fee) vehicles over 8,000 pounds to operate in Idaho, including those not eligible for other types of licensing and those who do not want to trip permit or have met the limit of three permits per vehicle per calendar year.

Commercial vehicles weighing from 8,001 through 26,000 pounds can be licensed through Motor Carrier Services (MCS) or through the local county assessor's office.

Idaho-based vehicles over 26,000 pounds and non-Idaho-based vehicles regardless of weight must be licensed through MCS.

Idaho farm vehicles through 60,000 pounds must license at a county assessor's office. Idaho farm vehicles over 60,000 pounds and those from out-of-state must be licensed through the MCS.
