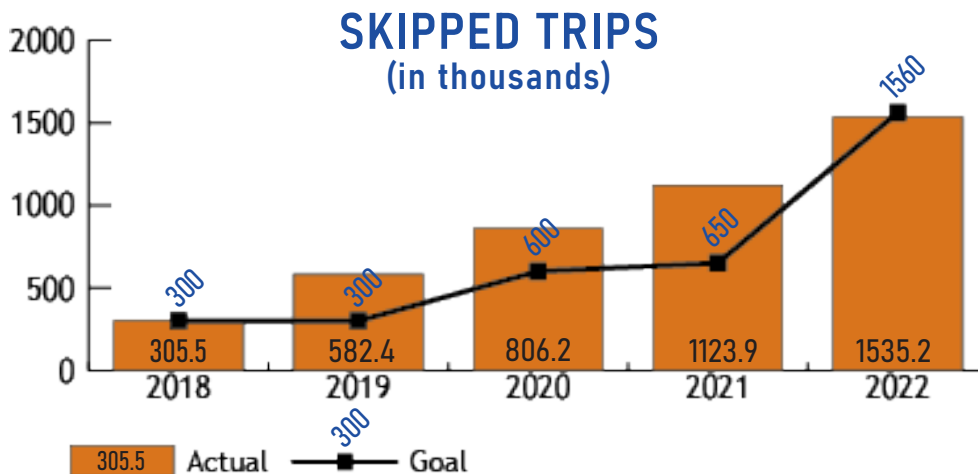

- Month-over-month thousands more people Skip the Trip

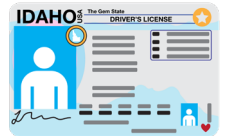
*Estimated Annual Savings Projection

TITLE & REGISTRATION AT DEALERSHIP

Buyers can register and title their vehicle electronically at the time of purchase at select Idaho dealers. Customers get titles faster than before.

ADVANCEMENTS IN TESTING

DMV rolled out two advancements in testing: a new driver's license Knowledge Testing System, and in-cab testing tablets for CDL Skills Examiners.

As of Jan 1, 2023, 44% of Idahoans have their Star Card. The new federal deadline to get a Real ID is May 7, 2025.
