Background and Project Information

Rail is one of the most established and oldest modes of transportation in the state. Today, rail is a critical component of Idaho's growing economy. It directly supports many of Idaho's most important and emerging industries, from mining and semiconducting manufacturing, to agriculture and fertilizer production.

It will also consider the needs of Idaho's passenger rail system, and related goals for ridership growth.

WINTER 2025:

Assessment of existing physical conditions, systemwide usage, and related characteristics, including ongoing stakeholder outreach.



SPRING 2025:

Development of draft State Rail Plan, including systemwide needs and the Rail Investment Plan.



SUMMER 2025:

Development of finalized State Rail Plan, including related findings and next steps.
