




I-90, WASHINGTON STATE LINE TO COEUR d' ALENE

State Highway 41 Interchange



WORK IN 2024 WILL INCLUDE:

- Finish work on the I-90 eastbound bridges.
- Continue to build the I-90 westbound bridges.
- Work on the westbound temporary bridge over SH-41.
- Pave eastbound and westbound I-90.
- Continue work on Seltice Way.
- Widen SH-41 to Mullan Avenue.



In 2024, the Idaho Transportation Department will continue reconstructing the interchange at I-90 and SH-41 in Post Falls and improving SH-41 and local roads surrounding the interchange.

DURING THE 2024 CONSTRUCTION SEASON:

- Crews will work Monday-Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Night work will be scheduled from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. During special events, night work will begin at 10 p.m.
- The speed limit will be lowered to 55 mph on I-90 and 25 mph on SH-41 and Seltice Way.
- Intermittent lane restrictions will occur on I-90 at night.
- Nighttime work will require lighting.
- Construction may be noisy and dusty.

FUTURE INTERCHANGE RENDERING



WHEN COMPLETE, IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Reconstructing over a mile of I-90 and making room for future widening of the interstate.
- Replacing the I-90, State Highway (SH-41) Interchange with a new design. All ramps will come together at a single point and be controlled by one traffic signal.
- Improving the SH-41 and Mullan Avenue intersection and local connectivity south of the Interchange.
- Adding two underpasses, one bridge, and one signal to provide safer, easier movements for pedestrians and cyclists through the Interchange and nearby trails.
