



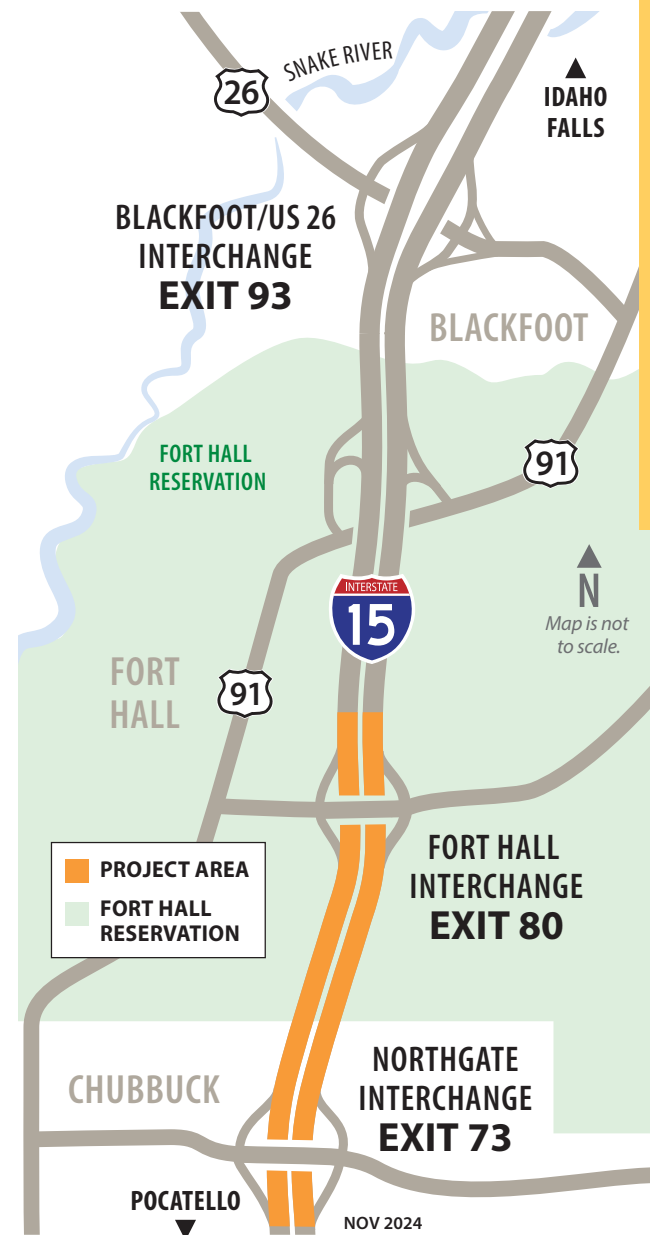
The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is widening Interstate 15 (I-15) to three lanes in each direction between the Northgate Parkway Interchange (Exit 73) and the Fort Hall Interchange (Exit 80). Additional improvements include:

- Constructing a barrier wall in the median.
- Improving bridges, overpasses and interchange structures.

These improvements will improve safety and increase capacity on I-15 to serve eastern Idaho for years to come.

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT ON I-15 DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- Nighttime lane restrictions.
- Traffic shifts and lane changes.
- Reduced speed limits.
- Ramp work and changes at exits 73 and 80. Temporary ramps may be shorter than current ramps.
- Work began in late summer 2024 and is expected to be completed in 2027.
