CENTENNIAL WAY TO >>> FRANKLIN ROAD

Construction is beginning on I-84 between Centennial Way and Franklin Road in Caldwell. This multi-year project, from late 2023 to early 2027, is part of the Idaho Transportation Department's ongoing work to improve I-84 in Canyon County.

CONSTRUCTION INCLUDES:

- > Widening I-84 between Centennial Way and Franklin Road Interchanges.
- > Replacing the 10th Avenue Interchange.
- > Adding a traffic signal at the Centennial Way Interchange westbound off-ramp.
- > Rehabilitating the pedestrian overpass.
- > Adding a soundwall along Hannibal Street from 10th Avenue to Centennial Way.

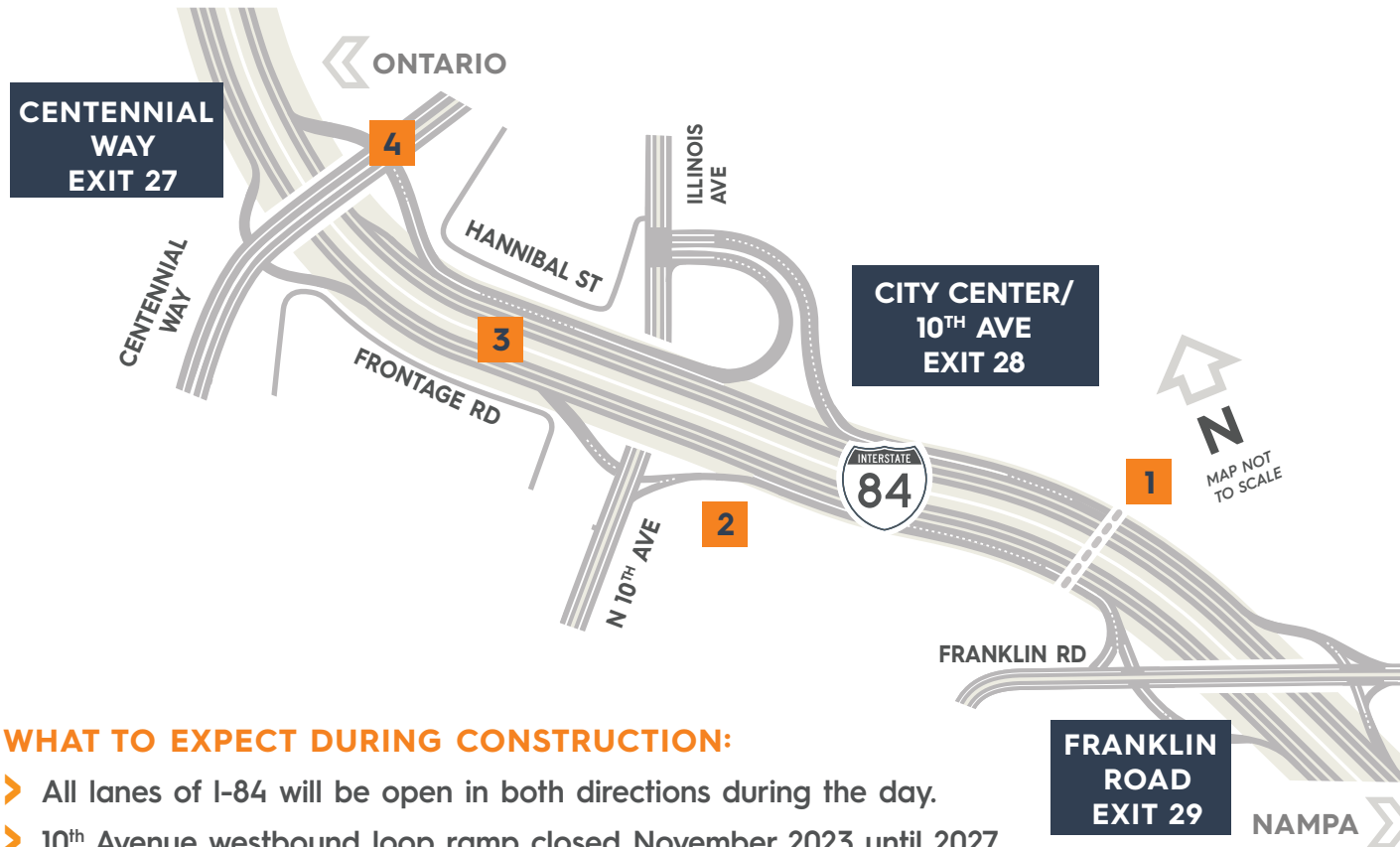

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

- All lanes of I-84 will be open in both directions during the day.
- 10th Avenue westbound loop ramp closed November 2023 until 2027.
- Overnight closures and lane restrictions will be necessary on I-84.
- Extended ramp closures at the Centennial Way and 10th Avenue interchanges (exits 27 and 28).
- Access to local businesses will be open, but your route may change.
- One way traffic on Hannibal Street and Frontage Road.

BEGINNING IN WINTER 2023, CONSTRUCTION CREWS WILL:

- Begin building the soundwall along Hannibal Street.
- Begin installing underground storm sewer along Hannibal Street and Frontage Road.
