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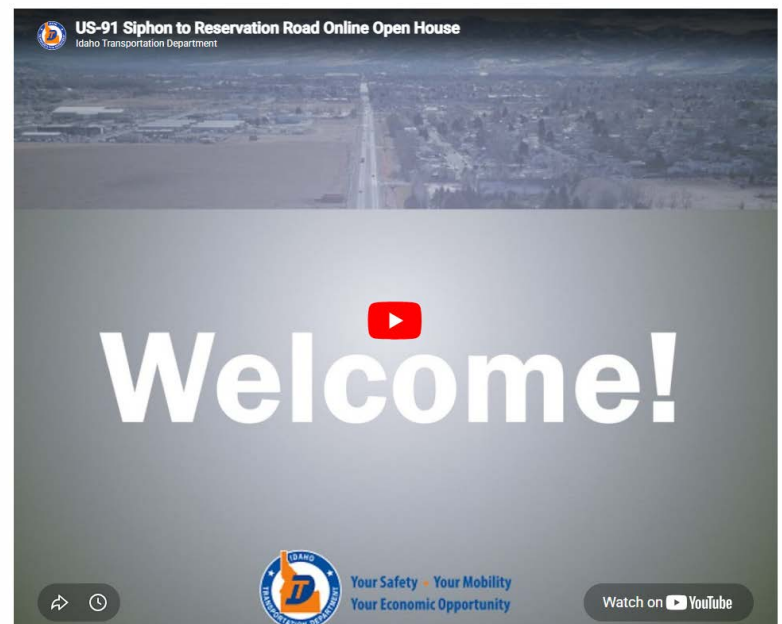
Welcome

Project Overview

Traffic volumes have increased in recent years, and ITD is developing plans that will accommodate continued growth in the area.

The purpose of this project is to improve safety and mobility on US-91 between Siphon Road and Reservation Road in Chubbuck. Use of US-91 has increased in recent years and the road is nearing capacity. This project includes:

- Completing an environmental evaluation.
- Gathering traffic and geotechnical information.
- Gathering input from local jurisdictions and the public.
- Developing design plans.



Process & Schedule



Community Input

ITD is gathering input from community members, city and county officials, and local leaders. Local knowledge about US 91 helps ITD develop design plans that will benefit all roadway users.

ITD will use input gathered at this public open house as the design process continues. The project team plans to hold another public open house to share the final design plans with the community and offer another opportunity to submit feedback.



Evaluation Criteria

ITD is evaluating preliminary design plans based on their ability to:

- Improve safety and traffic operations.
- Increase capacity to accommodate growth
- Minimize the acquisition of right of way.
- Minimize impacts to area residents and environmental resources.
- Improve US 91 in a cost-effective way.



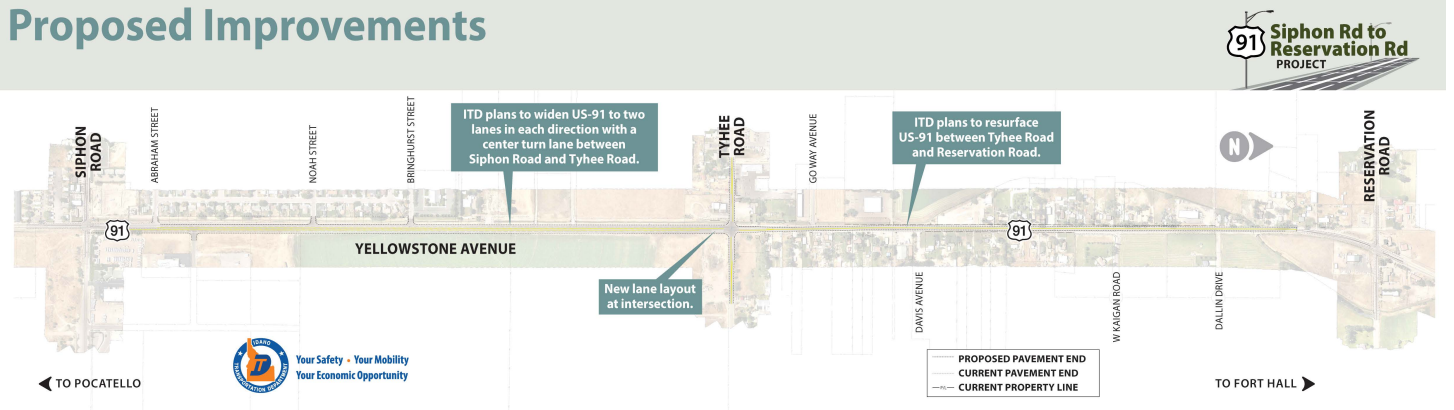
Proposed Improvements

Improvements will be designed using technical data, environmental studies and input from the public. Improvements featured in the preliminary design plans include:

- Widening US 91 to two lanes in each direction with a center turn lane between Siphon Road and Tyhee Road.
- Repairing US-91 between Tyhee Road and Reservation Road.
- Improving access to residential developments.

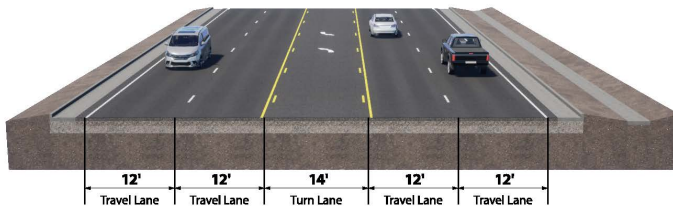


Proposed Improvements

South of Tyhee Road



US-91 between Siphon Road and Tyhee Road

Anticipated Improvements:

- Two lanes of traffic in each direction.
- Center turn lane.

US-91 / Tyhee Road Intersection

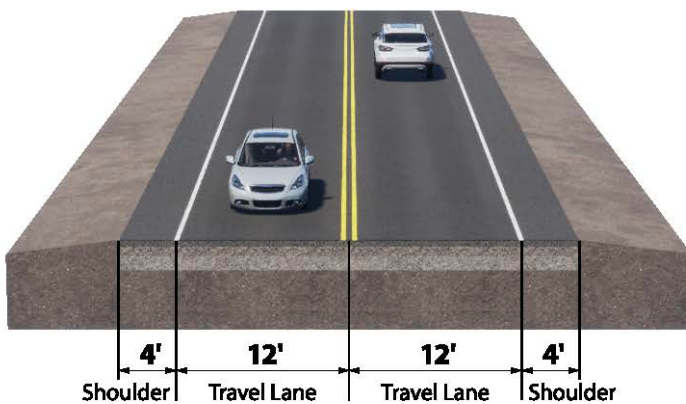
The newly widened US-91 (5 lanes) will tie into the current configuration (3 lanes).

Anticipated improvements include:

- Adding turn lanes.
- Increasing capacity in the queue lane.



North of Tyhee Road



US-91 between Tyhee Road and Reservation Road

Preliminary design plans include resurfacing US-91 between Tyhee Road and Reservation Road. The team plans to maintain all current US-91 access points.

US-91 Projects

US-91 Siphon Road to Reservation Road

ITD is developing plans to improve US-91 between Siphon Road and Reservation Road. The beginning of construction will be determined based on the availability of funding.

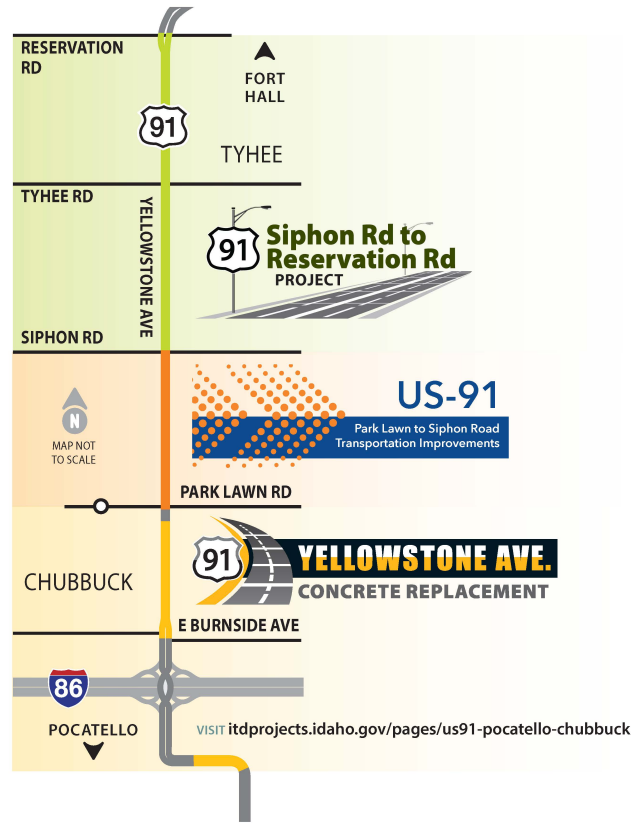
US-91 Park Lawn to Siphon Road

ITD is developing plans to expand US-91 from Park Lawn to Siphon Road. Construction is expected to begin in 2026.

Yellowstone Avenue Concrete Replacement

ITD is designing plans to rehabilitate two sections of Yellowstone Avenue in Pocatello and Chubbuck. Construction is expected to begin in 2026.

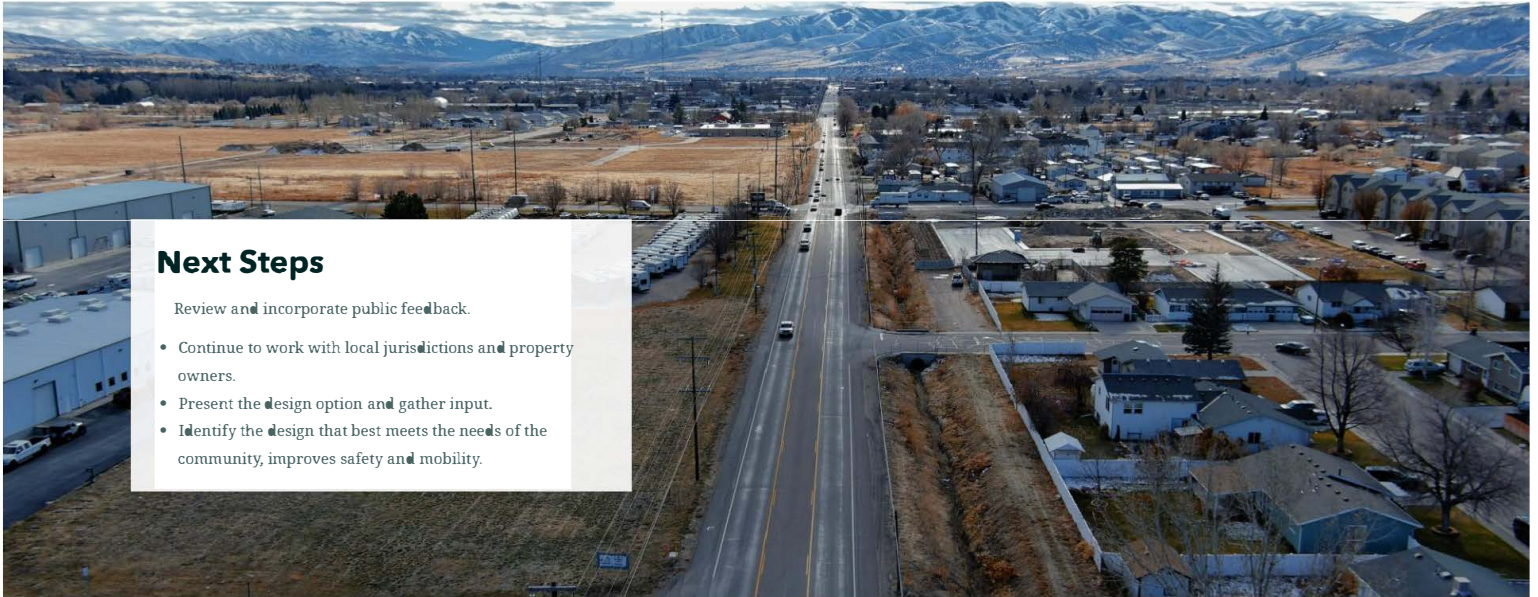

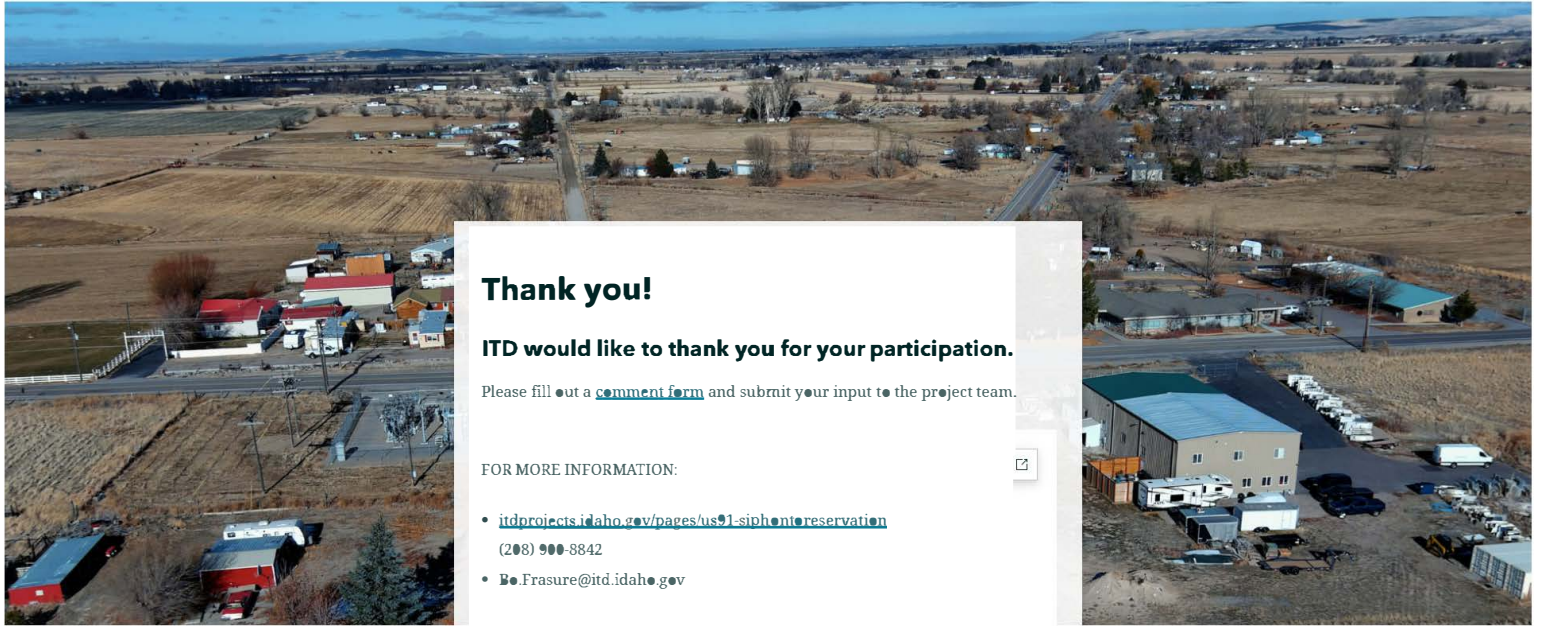


Next Steps
