



# Rapid River Bridge to Riggins

The Idaho Transportation Department is evaluating U.S. Highway 95 between the Rapid River Bridge and Riggins in Idaho County.

ITD is evaluating the current conditions of this section of US-95 to identify potential safety improvements. The purpose of the project is to enhance safety for all roadway users. Challenges include rockfalls, landslides, narrow shoulders and minimal guardrail between the roadway and the Little Salmon River.

## COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

ITD will work with local residents, community partners and agencies throughout the evaluation process.

## PROJECT SCHEDULE

Fall 2024	Begin concept evaluation process and coordination with agencies
Early 2025	Host open house to identify issues and gather ideas for US-95 Begin developing US-95 options
Summer/Fall 2026	Refine options for US-95 Host open house and gather feedback on options for US-95
Fall 2026	Finalize concept report Identify preferred options for US-95 and advance to design phase

The design phase is planned to begin in late 2026, and construction is currently scheduled for 2031.
