<b>Plate Program (Idaho Code)</b>	<b><u>Fund Name</u> <i>Responsible Organization</i></b> <b>Program Purpose (State Highway Account Fund Breakdown)</b>
<b>4-H (49-420M)</b>	<b><u>Friends of 4-H Division</u> <i>University of Idaho Foundation</i></b> Funds to be used for educational events, training materials for youth and leaders, and to better prepare Idaho youth for future careers. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Agriculture (49-417B)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Ag in the Classroom</u> <i>Department of Agriculture</i></b> Develop and present an education program for K-12 students with a better understanding of the crucial role of agriculture in all aspects of society and how Idaho agriculture relates to the rest of the world. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>An Appeal to Heaven</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Appaloosa (49-420D)</b>	<b><u>N/A</u> <i>Appaloosa Horse Club</i></b> Funding of youth horse programs in Idaho. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Armed Forces Reserve (49-404A)</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Aviation (49-420K)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Aviation Foundation</u> <i>Idaho Aviation Association</i></b> Funds used by the Idaho Aviation Foundation for grants relating to the maintenance, upgrade, and development of airstrips and for improving access and promoting safety at backcountry and recreational airports in Idaho. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Capitol Commission (49-420A)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Capitol Maintenance Reserve Fund – IC 67-1610A</u> <i>Capitol Commission</i></b> Funds used to address repair, maintenance, and construction needs approved by the commission to benefit the capitol building and its grounds. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Choose Life (49-420R)</b>	<b><u>N/A</u> <i>Choose Life Idaho, Inc.</i></b> Funds used in Idaho to provide grant dollars to support life-affirming pregnancy resource centers in order to help pregnant women choose life for their babies and to encourage adoption as a positive choice for women with unplanned pregnancies. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Classic (49-406A)</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Collegiate (49-418A)</b>	<b><u>Individual accounts of participating college or university</u> <i>State Board of Education</i></b> Funding of scholarships for Idaho residents attending that college or university (on the selected plate), and matching funds from non-state sources for academic purposes. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA). <b>Don't Tread on Me (49-420S)</b>	<b><u>Firearms Safety Grant Fund</u> <i>State Board of Education</i></b> Funds used exclusively for educational program grants in relation to firearm safety education in primary and secondary schools in Idaho. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Famous Potatoes (49-417C)</b>	<b><u>N/A</u> <i>Idaho Potato Commission</i></b> Conduct research and studies in connection with the raising, production, and marketing of potatoes. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Firefighters (49-418C)</b>	<b><u>N/A</u> <i>Idaho Fire Chief's Association</i></b> Funds exclusively used for the fire safety education of firefighters, fire chiefs, and the public. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Gold Star Family (49-403B)</b>	<b><u>Veterans Support Fund</u> <i>Division of Veteran Services</i></b> Funds are to be used by the IDVS to administer the eligibility certification process for applicants of this plate program. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Lewis and Clark (49-420B)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Lewis and Clark Trail Committee Fund</u> <i>Gov's Idaho Lewis and Clark Trail Committee</i></b> Utilized in support of the efforts of the advisory board to preserve the Lewis and Clark trail. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Old Timer (49-406)</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Peace Officer Memorial (49-420C)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Peace Officers Memorial Fund</u> <i>Idaho Community Foundation</i></b> Funds exclusively used for the Idaho law enforcement memorial and families of peace officers killed in the line of duty. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Pet Friendly (49-420Q)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Humane Society's Pet Lovers Fund</u> <i>Idaho Humane Society</i></b> Committee will designate recipients of monies from the fund to aid with veterinary services; prioritizing canine and feline spay and neuter services to low-income residents of Idaho. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Rangeland (49-417D)</b>	<b><u>Rangeland Resource Commission Account</u> <i>Idaho Rangeland Resource Commission</i></b> Youth education and outreach programs. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Sawtooth National Recreation Area (49-419A)</b>	<b><u>Parks and Recreation Fund</u> <i>Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation</i></b> Funds used for the maintenance of parks and facilities. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Selway-Bitterroot (49-420J)</b>	<b><u>Selway-Bitterroot Foundation</u></b> Funds used for assisting in the stewardship of the Idaho Selway-Bitterroot wilderness and surrounding wildlands of north central Idaho. (\$13 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Snowmobile (49-420)</b>	<b><u>State Snowmobile Account</u> <i>Idaho Department of Parks and Recreation</i></b> Funds distributed to counties to provide services benefiting snowmobilers (i.e., trail grooming, plowing and maintaining snowmobile park areas, facilities, and trail signing. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).

<b>Statehood Centennial (49-416)</b>	<b><u>Highway Distribution Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the highway distribution account.
<b>Street Rod (49-408)</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Support Our Troops (49-415D)</b>	<b><u>Idaho Support Our Troops, Inc</u> <i>Idaho Support Our Troops, Inc</i></b> Funds used to provide support and assistance to the children, dependents, and spouses of military service members and armed forces members. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>USS Idaho</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b> All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Timber (49-417A)</b>	<b><u>Department of Lands Fund</u> <i>State Board of Land Commissioners</i></b> Reforestation activities on state lands, or for educational efforts to help build public understanding of reforestation or management and conservation of forest resources. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Veteran (49-418)</b>	<b><u>Veterans Cemetery Maintenance Fund</u> <i>Idaho Veterans Affairs Commission</i></b> Funds exclusively used for the operation and maintenance of a state veterans cemetery. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Veteran Motorcycle (49-418D)</b>	<b><u>Veterans Cemetery Maintenance Fund</u> <i>Idaho Veterans Affairs Commission</i></b> Funds exclusively used for the operation and maintenance of a state veterans cemetery. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>White Water Rafting (49-419C)</b>	<b><u>Tourism and Promotion Fund</u> <i>Department of Commerce</i></b> Funds used for general education and promotion of Idaho's white-water rivers and the rafting and kayaking industries. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
<b>Wildlife (49-417)</b>	<p><b><u>Bluebird</u> 25.00/15.00 - <u>Non-game Trust Fund</u> <i>Dept. of Fish and Game</i></b> Coordinate research and surveys on little-understood, rare, threatened, or endangered Idaho animals. Provide info. &amp; educational materials on Idaho wildlife and wildlife viewing opportunities.</p> <p><b><u>Elk</u> 22.50/13.50 - <u>Non-game Trust Fund</u> <i>Dept. of Fish and Game</i></b>  <b>1.25/.75 - <u>Wildlife Disease Laboratory</u> <i>Dept. of Fish and Game</i></b> Testing, surveillance and detection of wildlife diseases including, but not limited to chronic wasting disease.</p> <p><b>1.25/.75 - <u>Livestock Disease Control Fund</u> <i>Dept. of Agriculture</i></b> Testing, surveillance and detection of wildlife and domestic livestock diseases including, but not limited to, brucellosis and chronic wasting disease.</p> <p><b><u>Trout</u> 22.50/13.75 - <u>Non-game Trust Fund</u> <i>Dept. of Fish and Game</i></b>  <b>2.50/1.25 - <u>Dept. of Parks and Rec. <b>Year of Manufacture</b>  <b>(49-407)</b>	<b><u>State Highway Account</u> <i>Idaho Transportation Department</i></b>  All revenue is deposited in the state highway account.
<b>Youth</b>  <b>(49-418B)</b>	<b><u>Youth Program Fund</u> <i>Sheriff Office in county where transaction took place</i></b>  Funds used for the implementation of prevention and early intervention programs for at-risk youth. (\$10 of the initial & renewal fees deposited into the SHA).
