Rules

- > Submit original hand drawn artwork
- → Paper size must be 11" x 17" (Landscape orientation)
- Must be two-dimensional watercolor, acrylic or oil, colored pencil, felt-tip marker, ballpoint pen, pen and ink, and/or crayon
- Must have a completed certificate of authenticity attached securely to the back of the piece of artwork (see page two for certificate)
- → No pencil, charcoal, collage, digital, or clip art

Prizes

- → First place winners: Invited to ride in an airplane and will receive a copy of their artwork signed by our Governor, plus a congratulatory letter
- Second place winners: \$25 in art supplies and a congratulatory letter
