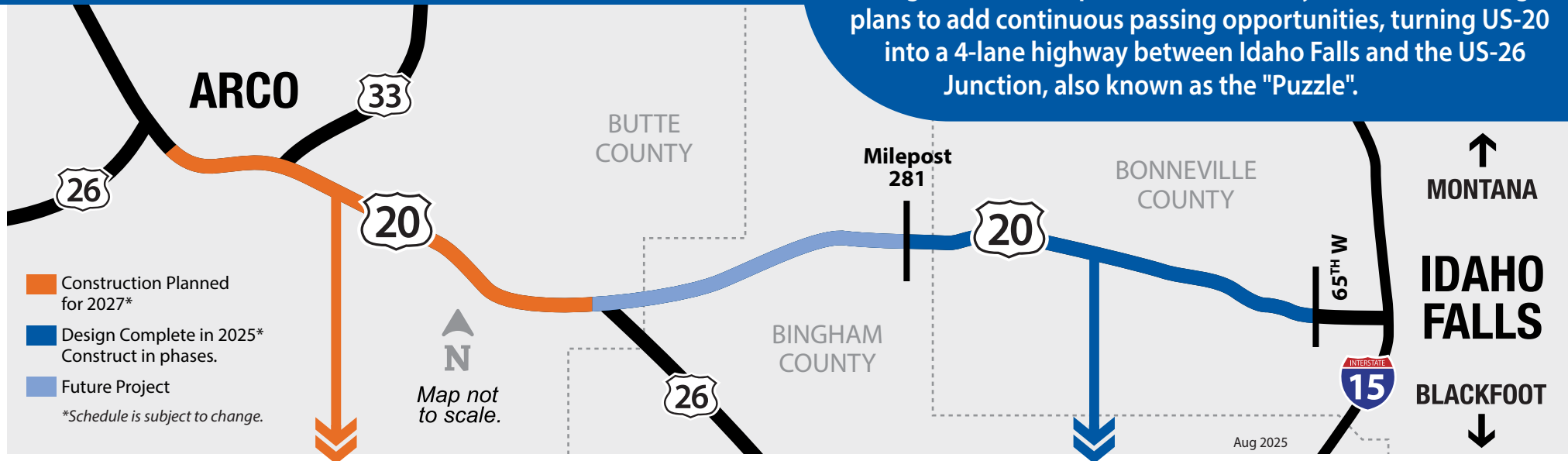


# US-20 Arco to Idaho Falls

The Idaho Transportation Department is making plans to improve US-20 between Arco and Idaho Falls. The existing 2-lane roadway, originally constructed in 1950, is deteriorating and needs to be rehabilitated and reconstructed to address existing issues and improve corridor safety. ITD is also making plans to add continuous passing opportunities, turning US-20 into a 4-lane highway between Idaho Falls and the US-26 Junction, also known as the "Puzzle".



## OVERLAYS Rehabilitation

Milling the worn surface and overlaying a new layer of asphalt on US-20 will improve its condition and extend the life of the road.

- **Arco to SH-33**  
Design complete in mid-2025, construction planned for 2027\*.
- **SH-33 to US-26**  
Design complete in mid-2025, construction planned for 2027\*.

## RECONSTRUCTION & 4-LANE CONFIGURATION Roadway Reconstruction & Safety Improvements

Reconstructing US-20 will address the deteriorating roadway conditions and failing roadway foundation. Adding continuous passing opportunities to US-20 will increase corridor safety and improve traffic flow.

- **Milepost 281 to Idaho Falls**  
Design complete in late 2025\*, construction of the 4-lane configuration will occur in phases, starting near Idaho Falls and working west.
- **US-26 to Milepost 281**  
Complete design plans and seek funding for construction in future.



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
