



STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Purpose

This policy designates the authority and responsibility for developing, adopting and maintaining standard specifications for construction projects.

Legal Authority

Board Policy 4013, STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

The Chief Engineer shall develop, adopt, and maintain standard specifications for construction of highway projects.

Work by state forces shall comply with the Standards Specifications to the extent which is practical. The following members will comprise a Standard Specification Committee: State Design/Materials/Construction Engineer (Chair), State Design Engineer, Bridge Engineer, State Materials Engineer, FHWA Representative, Construction Contractor representative, and District Representatives: one representative each from two districts for each meeting (1-6, in annual rotation), usually the Engineering Manager or Resident Engineer.

The Committee shall meet at least once but no more than twice each year to review and if necessary, modify-the Department's Standard Specifications.
