



IDAHO HIGHWAY MAP

Purpose

This policy defines the guidelines for creation and distribution of the Idaho Highway Map based on Board policy and a Memorandum of Understanding.

Authority

Idaho Code Sections 40-310 (2), and 40-314 (3)

Board Policy 4015, IDAHO HIGHWAY MAP

MOU between ITD and the Department of Commerce

The Manager of the Office of Communications shall solicit information to improve travel in Idaho from appropriate internal and external sources for inclusion on the official Idaho Highway Map, and through a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Commerce shall jointly produce the Idaho Highway Map.

The following guidelines shall be used in the information inclusion process:

- All state and interstate highways will be identified.
- County "Route-Marker" routes will be identified, if map scale allows.
- All other identified routes must be major collectors. Preference will be given to those routes that provide interstate service, serve recreational facilities, or connect traffic generators (including state highways).
- Routes in agricultural areas with grid networks, short stub routes, routes paralleling state highways, unsafe routes, and routes that are inaccessible by standard vehicles will **not** be included.
- Cities or towns with services, a post office or have cultural and historical significance will be included.

Inclusion of other information on the map shall be based on whether the information can be utilized by tourists and other interested parties. The Division of Transportation Performance shall screen the Idaho Highway Map data as it relates to road systems and route selection.

Upon request, the Idaho Highway Map may be distributed free of charge in reasonable quantities to individuals, schools, and non-profit groups representing Idaho. All other requests for the Idaho Highway Map, including federal, state, out-of-state and local government agencies, Chambers of Commerce and commercial or business enterprises shall be referred to the Idaho Department of Commerce.
