

# Drive Log Template

## Parent-Student On-Road Driver Training

Idaho Code Section 49-307 allows for students to receive behind-the-wheel training from their parents. This allows students to complete the equivalent training as those in a traditional driver education course. The minimum requirements for this training are:

- Thirty (30) hours of classroom instruction
- Six (6) hours of behind-the-wheel instruction\*
- Six (6) hours of in-car observation\*
- Submit a classroom instruction transcript or certificate of completion to the county driver's license office
- Submit driving log to the county driver's license office

***The supervised instruction period CANNOT begin until the classroom transcript/certificate of completion and driving log have been submitted to the Idaho Transportation Department or county driver's license office.***
