3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. *(drop in anytime)*

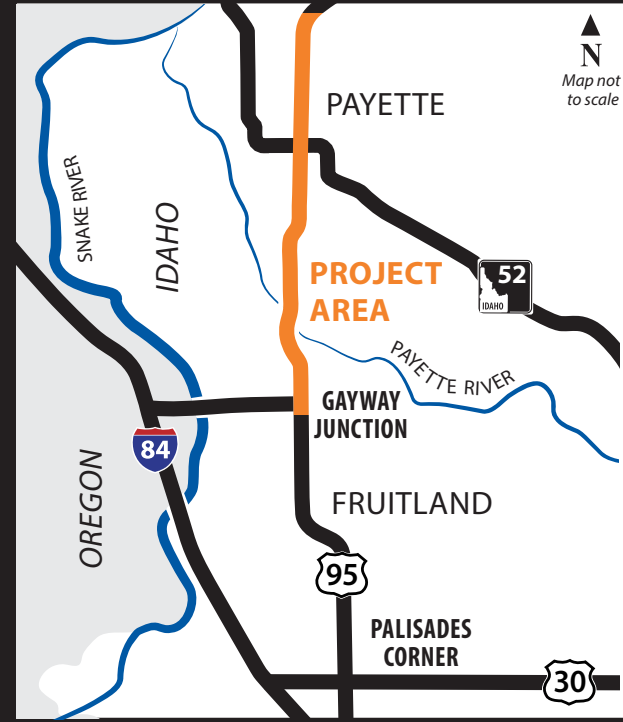
APRIL 23 IN FRUITLAND Fruitland High School (501 S Iowa Ave, Fruitland)

- Lane closures on US-95 depending on activity and location
 - Single lane closures
 - Reduced to one lane with flaggers when necessary
- Daytime and nighttime work
- Delays, consider using an alternate route

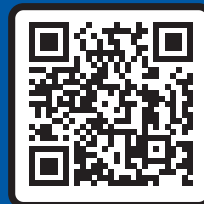

The Idaho Transportation Department is rehabilitating US-95 in Payette County this summer. Work will address a 5.3 mile stretch starting just south of Gayway Junction and ending north of Payette. Work started this spring and is expected to end in fall of 2026.
