We are pleased to submit the attached plans for the State of Idaho, as directed by Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) NEVI Formula Program Interim Guidance dated August 11, 2025.

This strategy outlines the deployment of NEVI-compliant stations within Idaho for the entirety of the program life cycle, from Fiscal Year 2022 through 2026. Attached please find the following:

- 2022 State of Idaho Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Baseline Plan (8/1/22);
- NEVI State of Idaho 2024 Baseline Plan Update (8/1/23);
- Siting, Feasibility and Access Study (4/24); and,
- NEVI State of Idaho 2025 Baseline Plan Update (9/1/24).

These four plans provide compliance with all NEVI statutory and regulatory requirements as stated in the FHWA guidance referenced above.

The State of Idaho requests FY 2022 through FY 2026 NEVI program funds allocated to the state. Idaho's strategy included the development of a Siting, Feasibility and Access Study (SFAS) over phases to achieve implementation and deployment. The SFAS was completed in April 2024. The most recent NEVI 2025 Baseline Plan Update (pages 28 - 34) includes all deployment and implementation plans and locations for construction, operation, and maintenance of stations across Idaho, as derived from the SFAS.

Similarly, a Community Engagement Outcomes Report is included in the 2022 Baseline Plan (pages 9 – 21), the 2024 Baseline Plan Update (pages 5 - 18), and the 2025 Baseline Plan Update (pages 6 – 23). Idaho received national recognition from FHWA for our outreach efforts.

Finally, physical and cybersecurity strategies are also included in all three plans listed above: 2022 – Page 54; 2024 – Page 47; and 2025 – Page 37.
