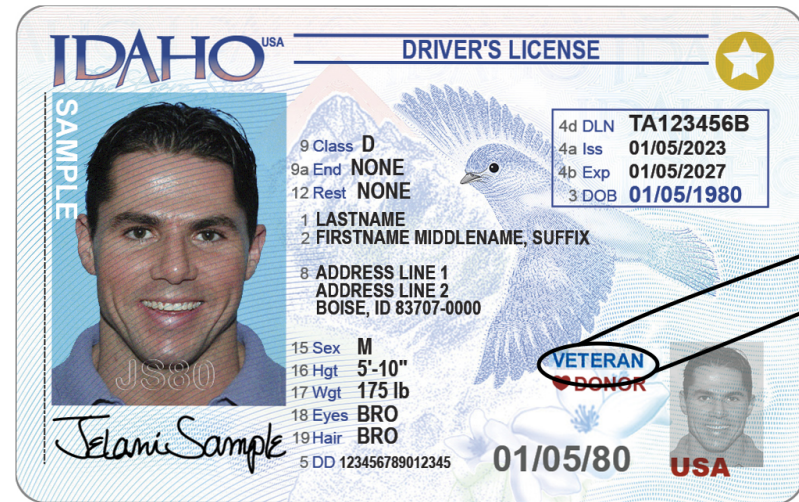

Veteran Designation on Idaho Driver's License and ID Cards

You must present an acceptable document to an Idaho driver's license office showing proof of honorable discharge from military service, a valid active-duty identification, or proof of having a veteran license plate.

The information will be entered into Idaho's driver database.

There will be no additional charge to add the veteran designation when obtaining a new or renewed Idaho driver's license or identification card.

There will be a duplicate fee to add a veteran designation at any other time. Fees can be found at dmv.idaho.gov under the Driver's License and Identification Card section.

The designation is permanent. There will be no additional cost unless you choose to have the designation removed.
