



Riverton Road Bridge

CONSTRUCTION OVERVIEW

The Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) is replacing the Riverton Road Bridge over Interstate 15 (I-15) near Blackfoot after it was struck by a vehicle in late 2025. The new bridge will allow I-15 to be widened to three lanes in each direction. The bridge will also accommodate improvements planned by the city of Blackfoot for Riverton Road. Construction began in May 2026 and is expected to be completed by the end of the year.

What to expect during construction

- I-15 lane closures
- Intermittent nighttime I-15 closures
- Crossover traffic patterns
- Reduced speed limits
- Riverton Road will remain closed between Frontage Road and Sweetwater Drive

Process and Schedule

Spring

Demolish the existing bridge and begin building bridge support walls.

Summer

Complete bridge support walls, build piers, place girders and begin work on the bridge deck.

Fall

Complete the bridge deck and roadway, install curb and gutters, guardrails, fencing and more to complete construction.



The new bridge features:

- Two 12-foot lanes
- Two 4-foot shoulders
- Two 6-foot sidewalks and safety fencing
- Increased vertical clearance of 23 feet
